EDAI R&D Awards

The EDAI Research and Development Awards are awards for scientific research in the field of child and adolescent mental health and neurodevelopment. The competition is at an international level.

Prizes

First prize of 1,000 euros
(for all the authors of the winning poster)

Second prize of 250 euros
(for all the authors of the winning poster)

EDAI is not responsible for how this amount is distributed among the authors.
(Prizes may be declared void if the quality of the posters is insufficient).

Areas of interest

Topics

All subjects in relation with the care of children, adolescents and families, in different healthcare disciplines, will be accepted:

- Neuropediatrics, Neonatology or Nursing.
- Psychiatry, Psychology, Psychotherapy, or Neuropsychology
- Speech therapy
- Social Work or Social Education
- Physiotherapy
- Occupational Therapy or Psychomotor Therapy
- Pedagogy, Psychopedagogy or Education
- Several of these disciplines at the same time (multidisciplinary)
- Other disciplines related to those described above



Guidelines

General rules

In order to participate, at least 1 of the authors of the poster (in case of multiple authors) must register for the EDAI International Conference.

The papers may:

- a) have been presented/exhibited at other conferences, journals or educational events.
- b) be an unrepresented work (original).

Both theoretical and empirical posters will be accepted.

How to present a poster

Send two copies of the poster or an abstract of maximum 500 words if preferred, with 4-5 keywords, attached in PDF:

- 1) One copy with name and affiliation.
- 2) A second copy with a pseudonym (without name or affiliation).

The deadline for submission is [05/05/2025](#).

A blind review will be carried out by external reviewers and the authors will be informed of the acceptance or rejection of the poster within 7 days.

* If the poster has already been exhibited, EDAI is not legally responsible (in case of litigation, the authors of the poster are responsible for having requested the permissions from the journal or institution to which the work was previously presented).

Posters

Theoretical posters

- Dimensions: 90 cm high x 60 cm wide
- Authors, affiliation, telephone and e-mail address
- Background (or introduction/state of the question)
- Objectives
- Conceptual development and reflections on a concept or a clinical experience.
- Conclusions
- References

Empirical posters

- (a) Projects with final results as well as ongoing projects without results will be accepted.
- (b) Single case studies will be accepted, as will larger sample sizes.
- Size: 90 high x 60 wide
- Authors, affiliation, telephone and e-mail address
- Background
- Objectives
- Methods
- Results
- Conclusions
- References
